



Financial Policy for Private Insurance

Please read carefully and initial the following:

____ Most dental insurance policies do NOT cover 100% of the cost of your treatment. We encourage you to think of your insurance as more of a coupon toward your treatment. You will be responsible to pay the deductible, if any, and your co-pay the day service is rendered. We will estimate as closely as possible what your co-pay will be, but until we receive payment from your insurance, it is only an estimate.

____ We will assist you in dealing with the insurance company, but ultimately, the responsibility lies with you. If after 45 days the insurance still has not paid, the balance will be your responsibility and due in full.

If Applicable:

Minor patients must be accompanied by an adult. The parent or legal guardian will be responsible for any payments. For unaccompanied minors, non emergency services will be denied unless charges have been pre-authorized to an approved credit plan, credit card, or payment by cash or check at the time of service.

Missed Appointment Policy

Due to a lot of missed unconfirmed appointments we now require patients to confirm by a certain given date or they will be at risk of losing their appointment to someone who did confirm. We require all patients to give us 24 hours notice for any cancellation. We do understand emergencies do happen, however after the third missed appointment and every one without a 24 hours notice, we charge a \$50.00 appointment fee.
